The Keith and Judy Swayne Family Foundation is interested in increasing awareness of emerging and ongoing issues of the region. This forum will provide learning from the perspective of those in the field and allow for an exchange of ideas among funders.

### **ISSUES**

The issues facing Orange County youth are too many to list. According to the 17th Annual Report on the Conditions of Children in Orange County, as families throughout the county struggle economically, more children are qualifying for welfare services and free or reduced-price school lunches, and their reading scores are plummeting.

In a special section of the report focused on the impact of domestic and family violence on children, they report that on average, 111 reports of child abuse are made each day. In 2010, 23 deaths related to domestic violence were reported.

Come hear two respected non-profit leaders discuss the state of youth development in Orange County and how they hope to improve the future of our community.

### **Rusty Kennedy, OC Human Relations**

Raised in Fullerton, Rusty Kennedy has served as Executive Director of the Orange County Human Relations Commission since 1981 and as the founding CEO of the non-profit Orange County Human Relations Council, established 1991.

OC Human Relations reaches over 40,000 middle and high schools students annually building their capacity to create safe, inclusive schools where bullying, put downs and disrespect are discouraged. Through BRIDGES anti-bullying and violence prevention program OC Human Relations has reached over 500,000 students over the last decade.

Kennedy leads this dynamic public/private partnership that includes the nationally recognized BRIDGES: School Inter-Group Relations and Violence Prevention Program, a Mediation/Conflict Resolution Program, and a Community Building Program that includes Diverse Leadership Development, Police/Community Relations Training, Collaborative Community Planning, Living Room Dialogues and Civil Rights advocacy.

### **Robert Santana, Boys & Girls Club of Santa Ana**

Robert is a native of Santa Ana, and after serving our country in the United State Air Force, he returned home to impact the lives of young people in his community.

Robert's passion to impact the lives of youth led him to the Boys & Girls Club of Santa Ana. As the leader of the Boys & Girls Club of Santa Ana, he has brought vision and leadership to an organization with almost 60 years of impact .
